

# Pascagoula River Audubon Marsh Mitigation Project

5107 Arthur Street, Moss Point

Located on the site of the Pascagoula River Audubon Center near the mouth of Rhodes Bayou, this outdoor laboratory project will develop and provide educational experiences to public and private land managers about practical tidal wetland mitigation methods and practices through hands-on workshops. The project is receiving funding from Southern Company, the parent company of Mississippi Power, and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency through a 2015 Five Star and Urban Waters grant from the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation (NFWF). The Five Star and Urban Waters program provides financial assistance to local partnerships for wetland, forest, streamside and coastal habitat restoration.
